## The Unseen Hand of God

In John 11 we read of the sickness and death of Lazarus. Jesus had been told well in advance of the serious illness of his friend. But instead of coming immediately to heal him, Jesus waited several days before he came to visit. Our Savior knew well in advance that Lazarus would soon die. When he finally arrived in Bethany, the first thing Martha said was, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died" John 11:21. A few minutes later Mary told Jesus as well, "If you had been here, my brother would not have died" John 11:32. Filled with emotion, Jesus wept with his friends and then raised Lazarus from the dead.
